Beginning this spring and continuing into October, Johns Hopkins' Evergreen Museum & Library will host a five-part kitchen garden series presented by Chef John Shields and his restaurant, Gertrude's, highlighting three seasons of sustainably growing and preparing fresh local produce.

The series will include hands-on gardening workshops led by sustainable farming expert Jon Carroll, cooking demonstrations, an optional chef's tour of Baltimore's 32nd Street Farmers' Market, and a concluding luncheon at Gertrude's. Participants will receive printed material on kitchen garden planning, organic growing techniques, and recipes incorporating the featured crops.
