‘PRINT BY PRINT: SERIES FROM DÜRER TO LICHTENSTEIN’

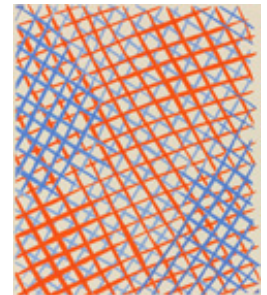

Sweeping in scope, this large-scale exhibition is an epic tour of serial printmaking, featuring more than 350 prints, spanning 500 years. Singled out by *The Baltimore Sun* as the Critic’s Pick for Fall 2011, nearly 30 complete series of prints—most never before shown in their entirety at the Museum—reveal the true vision of renowned artists, including Dürer, Picasso, Canaletto, Lichtenstein, Duchamp, and many more.

Presented thematically, *Print by Print* brings together exciting and elegant designs; gripping narratives; dramatic examples of appropriation; and poignant images of war. All of the series, portfolios, and sets of prints featured in the exhibition are drawn from the BMA’s works on paper collection, considered to be one of the most significant in the country, with nearly 60,000 prints.

Print by Print’s works and themes were selected by students participating in The Johns Hopkins University’s spring 2011 course Paper Museums: Exhibition Prints at the Baltimore Museum of Art. Rena Hoisington worked with the students to select and write labels for the 29 series on view.
